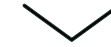

What is a benchmark?



The Benchmark is a reference for comparison purposes. It makes it possible to measure the performance of a mandate or a security, and to evaluate it in relation to this reference. The stock indices are, for example, benchmarks. Thus, to measure the performance of a stock listed on the Stoxx Europe 600, its evolution over a given period is compared with the index. If the stock's performance is superior, it is said to outperform the index.

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
